### Planned strategy:

- **Teaching and whole-school strategies.**

This will include strategies to support great teaching, refinement of assessment and feedback practices and transition support.

- **Targeted support.**

This will include One to one and small group tuition, intervention programmes and extended school time.

- **Wider strategies.**

Supporting parents and carers, and access to technology.

We are registered with the National Tutoring Programme and are devising curriculum plans on the 3 tiered approach detailed above. For many pupils, compensating for the negative impact of school closures will require a sustained response and it is highly unlikely that a single approach will be enough. It will also be beneficial to align our approaches with Pupil Premium spending and broader academy improvement priorities.
